- Kulliyyah (Faculty) of Laws was established on 20th May 1983 – as the first two faculties during IIUM establishment.
- In 2000, renamed as Ahmad Ibrahim Kulliyyah of Laws (AIKOL), in the honour of the late Professor Emeritus Tan Sri Dato' Ahmad bin Mohamed Ibrahim: the founding father of the Kulliyyah and a legendary figure in the Malaysian legal education.
- AIKOL is one of the best Law Schools in Malaysia with particular focus on the harmonisation of Civil Law and Islamic Law.
- Now with 90 academic staffs with more than 80% possessing Ph.D.
- Offers Degree, Masters and PhD in law.
- Three departments in the Kulliyyah:
 - Department of Islamic Law;
 - Department of Civil Law; and
 - Department of Legal Practice

Vision

 To become the premier Law School in the region with the highest standards of academic and intellectual excellence, with particular focus on the harmonisation of Civil Law and Shari'ah Law.

Legal Aid Services

- IIUM Legal Aid Services was previously known as IIUM Legal Clinic. It was established since IIUM inception, initiated by Alm. Tan Sri Prof Emeritus Ahmad Ibrahim on ad hoc basis.
- The clinic was relaunched on 22nd July 2000 and assumed the name of the Syariah Legal Clinic on the advice of the late Prof Ahmad before his demise. This was due to the fact that at that point of time, the clinic handled mostly Syariah cases.
- Occasionally, postgraduate students were invited to attend the sessions with the permission from the client.
- Due to the wide acceptance from the local communities, the scope of legal clinic has been extended to include Syariah and Civil matters. The clinic which is run by the panel of consultants from the AIKOL is continues until today.

The Objectives of LAS

To provide legal counselling and advice as well as a forum of reference on Malaysian Law;



To organise legal awareness and legal literacy programme;

To provide legal counselling and consultancy service on all areas of laws both in Islamic and Civil Law to the community and the IIUM community in particular;

To provide a platform for lecturers to upgrade their practical knowledge on the application of law;

To collaborate with relevant agencies in enhancing the understanding on the legal issues;

To provide a forum of research among lecturers and anyone interested in expanding laws in Malaysia.




Services Provided by the LAS

- 1. Provide assistance to individuals or groups who face legal problems (Civil and Shariah)
- 2. Counselling on legal problems involving Civil and Shariah Laws
- 3. Legal Representation in Court: A follow up service when counselling cannot resolve the problems of individuals or groups.

The cases will be brought to the panel lawyers in cases involving marriage and divorce, child care and custody, property and other ancillary matters, maintenance of wife and child, inheritance claims and Shariah criminal cases.
